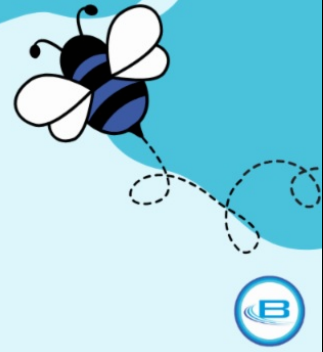

The June Recycling Day will be held on June 15 from 9-11:30am in the Public Works parking lot. Residents will be able to dispose of:

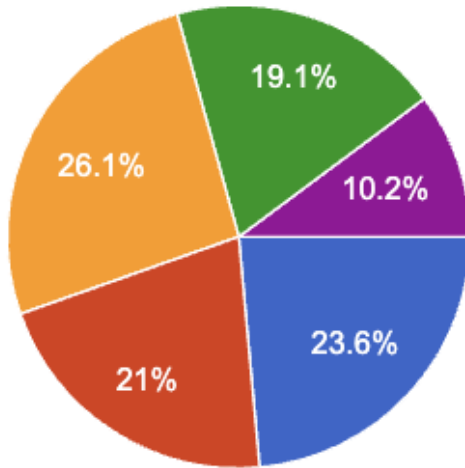
- Recycling

OPEN BOOK

MAY 6th - JUNE 18th

The Open Book period will last for 1 month. During this time, if you have questions about your assessment, you may set an appointment to review your new value with the assessor.

Please set your appointment online and an assessor will call you at your appointed time. We are offering phone appointments daily.

Would you like to speak with an assessor about the value of your home? You can schedule an appointment now until June 18 on a first come first served basis.

WHAT IS BOARD OF REVIEW?

 Before signing up for Board of Review, please either attend the Open Book or submit a **Request For Assessment Review** form on accurateassessor.com.

 Board of Review functions like a court and is required to **evaluate using evidence based on facts**.

 You or your representative must provide **factual evidence** that your property is inequitably assessed.

 To file for Board of Review **you must contact the clerk no later than 48 hours before** the hearing.

 The burden of proof is solely on you the taxpayer. **The assessor's value is presumed correct by state law until proven otherwise.**

Youth Citizens Academy

The Bayside Youth Citizens Academy is a new program offered to residents of Bayside, ages 13-17. The program aims to provide a closer look at the operations of local government and the jobs of those who work for the Village.

The Academy will be comprised of five interactive learning sessions led by Village staff who will provide participants with an in-depth look at Village departments and operations including, but not limited to, police, fire and EMS, public works, emergency dispatching, elections, budgeting, and property taxes. Not only will participants learn about the operations, but also tour the facilities. Yes, that means spend time in jail, listen to 911 calls, sit in the garbage truck, and more.

Sessions will be held on specified Wednesday afternoons from 2-3:30pm.

Did You Know?

The Bayside Public Safety Communications Center utilizes an emergency notification system, CodeRED, which allows North Shore Public Safety Departments to send emergency notifications to subscribers via email, text and phone calls.

In case of an emergency, individuals within the effected geographic area will be notified via text, phone, or email. There is no need to sign up for life-threatening emergency alerts.
