Upcoming Yard Waste Collection

The next yard waste collection of the season starts Monday, July 29. Below are a few reminders from the DPW.

□Yard waste must be out before 7:00am on Monday, July 29 to ensure your items will be picked up.

□ Yard waste must be at least 3 feet away from mailboxes and other structures, branches must be less than 5' long, branches must be parallel to the road, and cannot be in plastic bags.

□Yard waste should be placed in bags or yard waste carts if possible.

□ Prohibited materials, dirt, grass, sod, etc. will not be collected.

 \Box If your pile is greater than 10' long x 5' wide x 5' high, you will need a special pickup which can be requested here:

Grazing Goats Coming Soon!

The Grazing Goats will once again be returning to the Village of Bayside.

The goats will be utilized to clear approximately 3.5 acres of stormwater management facilities near the North Shore Fire Department on Brown Deer Road in Bayside.

A few reminders about the goats:

- Do not touch the electric fence that is enclosing the gate.
- Refrain from parking on Brown Deer Road or NSFD parking lot to view the goats.
- The public is not permitted within the fenced in area.

WIS 32 Project Public Meeting

The Wisconsin Department of Transportation invites you to an open house public involvement meeting to discuss the WIS 31 resurfacing project. The project proposes to rehabilitate 1.18 miles of WIS 32 in Milwaukee County, from E Dean Road to N Mohawk Road.

Construction is currently scheduled for 2029 but could occur as early as 2028 if funding becomes available.

Proposed project details

- 4-inch mill and overlay with spot base patching/full depth pavement replacement.
- All curb ramps will be replaced to meet ADA standards. Several pedestrian
- crossings will be re-aligned throughout the project area.
- Repair and clean existing culverts at multiple locations.
- Ditching/grading will occur at multiple locations.
- Traffic staging options are still being evaluated.
