Board of Review

Did you receive a Notice of New Value? The average residential increase is 4.7%.

The Board of Review will meet on **June 26, 2024 at 6pm** for a minimum of 2 hours. The Board of Review functions like a court and is required to evaluate using evidence based on facts.

You or your representative must provide factual evidence that your property is inequitably assessed.

You must confirm participation in the scheduled hearing at least 48 hours in advance by contacting the Village Clerk either by email (rsafstrom@baysidewi.gov) or by telephone at 414-206-3913.

WHAT IS BOARD OF REVIEW?



Before signing up for Board of Review, please either attend the Open Book or submit a **Request For Assessment Review** form on accurateassessor.com.



Board of Review functions like a court and is required to **evaluate using evidence based on facts**.



You or your representative must provide **factual evidence** that your property is inequitably assessed.



To file for Board of Review **you must contact the clerk no later than 48 hours before** the hearing.



The burden of proof is solely on you the taxpayer. **The assessor's value is presumed correct by state law until proven otherwise.**
