Yard Waste Collection Reminders

The next full yard waste collection of the year will be conducted the week of July 1.

- Yard waste must be out before 7am on Monday, July 1 to ensure your items will be picked up.
- Yard waste must be at least 3 feet away from mailboxes and other structures, branches must be less than 5' long, branches must be parallel to the road, and cannot be in plastic bags.
- Yard waste should be placed in bags or yard waste carts if possible.
- If your pile is greater than 10' long x 5' wide x 5' high, you will need a special pick-up which can be requested <u>here</u>.
