- Make checks payable to the Village of Bayside.
- Endorse your escrow check if it is also made out to you.
- If paying by mail, enclose a self-addressed, stamped envelope for receipt.

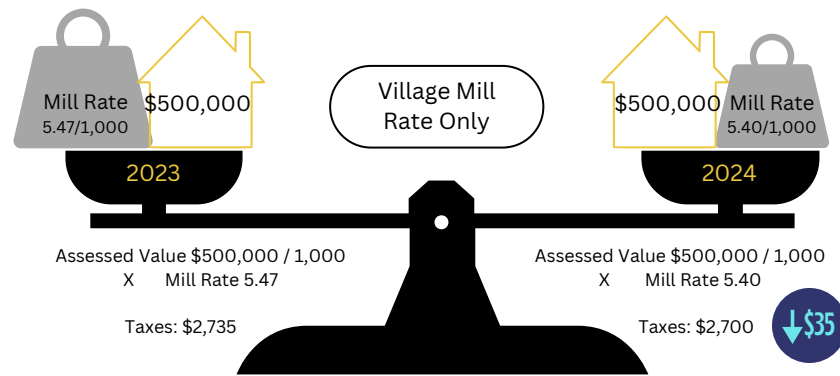
What's A Mill Rate?

$$\text{MILL RATE} = \frac{\text{Total Taxes Needed}}{\text{Total Assessed Value}}$$

It is a simple mathematical fact, if the levied tax amount stays the same and assessed values increase, the mill rate will fall, and your taxes will stay about the same.

The Mill Rate is calculated by dividing the total taxes needed by the total assessment value of the community.
