YARD WASTE TIPS

Place your piles and bags by the road, three (3) feet away from mailboxes and other structures.

- Branches must be less than 5' long and arranged parallel to the road.
- Do not put yard waste in plastic bags, garbage carts, or recycling carts.
- Do not put pet waste in yard waste piles, bags, or containers.
- Do not place yard waste on a property other than your own.
- Combine all materials into one (1) pile per property.
- Piles greater than 10' long x 5' wide x 5' high require a special pick-up. Special pick-ups can be requested online through Access Bayside.
- Contractor-generated yard waste is not collected by the Village. Please make sure your contractor takes yard waste with them when done.
- Crews will pass by each home once. If you miss the yard waste collection, you can request a special pick-up for a fee of \$80.
- Yard waste can be dropped off on Recycling Days.

VACATION CHECKS

Headed out of town? If so, have the Police Department check in on your home and property to ensure everything is exactly as you left it for your return.

Alternatively, the Public Works crew will load your car or trailer full of mulch for a \$75 loading fee.

RAILROAD CROSSING SAFETY

Injuries and deaths occur at railroad crossings every day, but most of these tragedies are preventable. Conscientious motorists keep themselves informed and their passengers safe. Unless you're at a crossing, it's illegal to be on or near tracks in any sort of vehicle. Ensuring your own safety, as well as that of your own passengers and of anyone else in the vicinity, requires hypervigilance. It's easy for drivers to forget that even in an emergency, trains can take a mile or more to stop. They're also three feet wider than the tracks – on both sides.

Here are 7 Simple Steps for Safely Navigating Railroad Crossings:

1. Stop, look both ways, and listen. Remember that trains always have the right of way.
2. Make sure you have room to get across. Once you enter the crossing, keep moving.
3. Stop 15' away from flashing red lights, lowered gates, a signaling flagman, or a stop sign.
4. Never try to drive around a lowering gate. Never ignore signals, and always use caution.
5. Before you begin to cross, wait for gates to fully raise and for all lights to stop flashing.
6. Never assume that there is only one train coming from a single direction.
7. If your car stalls in a crossing, get out and call the number on the sign, or 911.



Renting the pavilion costs \$85 (\$50 daily rental fee + \$35 refundable security deposit) for Bayside residents and \$275 (\$75 daily rental fee + \$200 refundable security deposit) for non-residents. MAILBOX REPLACEMENT PROGRAM

Is your mailbox straight, stable, and sturdy? Does your mailbox need to be replaced? The Department of Public Works will replace your old or damaged mailbox with a new mailbox consisting of one (1) standard black box and one (1) standard wood post at a cost of \$200. To request a mailbox replacement, visit Access Bayside and fill out a service request. Payment can be made online or in person at Village Hall. Payment must be made prior to installation. Mailboxes are installed to USPS standards. Mailboxes come with a one-year warranty from date of purchase.

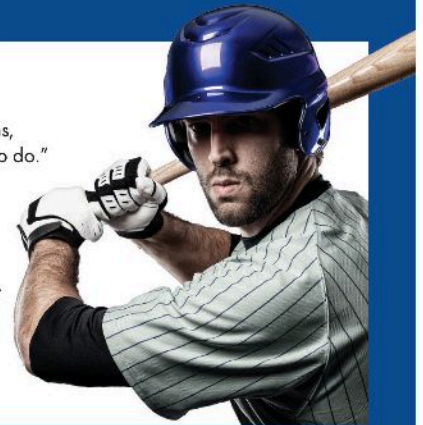
