



Weight Limits Coming Soon

During the spring thaw, warming temperatures lead to soft conditions which put the structural strength and base of streets at risk. Weight limits are placed on streets to protect against damage.

Weight limits will be effective on Monday, March 10. All interior Village streets are subject to the three (3) ton weight limit until further notice. Offenders are subject to a municipal citation.

Village streets not in effect:

- Fairy Chasm Road
- Regent Road (Fairy Chasm Road > Brown Deer Road)
- Brown Deer Road
- Lake Drive

Licenses are required for pets aged five (5) months and older. Proof of current rabies vaccinations with the rabies certificate number and expiration date must be provided to issue the license.

Licenses must be renewed each year. The deadline to apply without an additional fee is March 31.

fees (\$90) must be paid in advance. Please bring your receipt with you to dispose of TVs or monitors. Garbage is not accepted on Recycling Day.

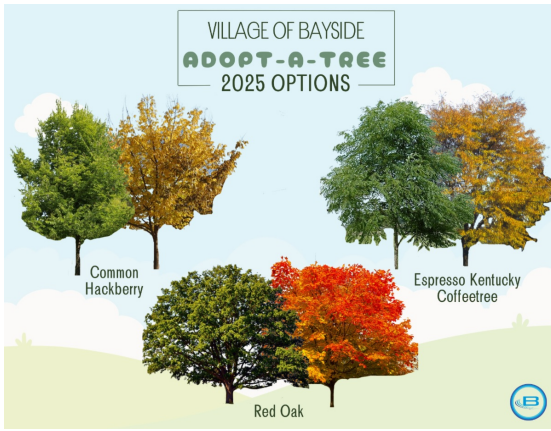

Adopt-A-Tree

The 2025 Adopt-A-Tree program is now live with three tree options for you to choose from. The Adopt-A-Tree program is a partnership program between the Village and you to help promote tree diversification and increase our tree canopy!

2025 Tree Options:

- Common Hackberry
- Espresso Kentucky Coffeetree
- Red Oak

2025 Location Options:

- Public Right-of-way Tree: Cost per tree is \$300 and includes 1 tree, planting in the public right-of-way, mulching, and initial watering.
- Private Property Tree: Cost per tree is \$350 and only includes the tree. Trees can be planted anywhere on your private property.

Starting May 7, 2025, if you plan to fly within the U.S., visit a military base or other federal buildings, you will need to have identification that is REAL ID compliant (or show another acceptable form of identification, such as a passport).

Passed by Congress in 2005, the REAL ID Act enacted the 9/11 Commission's recommendation that the Federal Government "set standards for the issuance of sources of identification, such as driver's licenses." The Act established minimum security standards for state-issued driver's licenses and identification cards and prohibits certain federal agencies from accepting for official purposes licenses and identification cards from states that do not meet these standards.
