Election Day: April 1

The Spring Election will be held on Tuesday, April 1. The polls will be open from 7am to 8pm. Bayside residents have one (1) polling location - 9075 N Regent Rd, Bayside, WI: Village Hall Board Room. All voters will enter through the front door of Village Hall.

All voters must have a photo ID when voting. Acceptable forms of photo ID can be found [here](#).

If you are registering to vote on Election Day, you must provide photo ID and [Proof of Residence](#).

If you are returning your absentee ballot on Election Day, please bring it to the Clerk's Office (front counter), not to the polling room.

Pet Licenses Reminder

2025 Dog and Cat Licenses are now available. Apply in person at Village Hall or online.

Licenses are required for pets aged five (5) months and older. Proof of current rabies vaccinations with the rabies certificate number and expiration date must be provided to issue the license.

Licenses must be renewed each year. The deadline to apply without an additional fee is March 31.

Get Prepped for Yard Waste Collections

The first full yard waste collection of the year will be conducted the week of April 7.

- Yard waste must be out before 7am on Monday, April 7, to ensure your items will be picked up.
- Yard waste must be at least 3 feet away from mailboxes and other structures, branches must be less than 5' long, branches must be parallel to the road and cannot be in plastic bags.
- Yard waste should be placed in bags or yard waste carts if possible.
- If your pile is greater than 10' long x 5' wide x 5' high, you will need a special pick-up which can be requested [here](#).
