All requests to contest a parking citation MUST be made within 60 days of the date the parking citation was issued. Citations issued beyond the 60 limit will NOT receive a Court date and cannot be contested.

To avoid a late fee, you must contest a parking citation within 10 days of the date the citation was issued. Late Fee Schedule information is located on the front of your citation.
