

## COMMUNITY MAPPING LEGEND

Please identify specific areas that you think should be singled out for special focus in the Comprehensive Plan. Use the color-coded features described below to indicate individual sites and delineate specific corridors.

<b><u>ORANGE DOT:</u> INFILL AND REDEVELOPMENT OPPORTUNITIES</b>	Redevelopment opportunities include buildings and larger sites in the community that are run-down or incompatible with adjacent properties and are now appropriate for physical improvements or a new use altogether. Infill areas could include vacant or underutilized lands that may be appropriate for new development.
<b><u>BLUE DOT:</u> PRESERVATION AREAS</b>	Individual sites and larger areas of natural, environmental, cultural, or historic value that should be preserved or restored, such as open green space, creek corridors, historic buildings, wooded areas, etc.
<b><u>GREEN DOT:</u> GATHERING PLACES</b>	Public places such as schools, libraries, community centers, parks, churches, and public markets where the Village should improve existing facilities or where new facilities are needed.
<b><u>PINK DOT:</u> TRANSPORTATION ISSUES</b>	Areas where roadways are in need of improvement or extension, where congestion occurs, where dangerous intersections are located, potential public transit improvements, etc.
<b><u>YELLOW STAR:</u> NEW RESIDENTIAL</b>	Areas where the Village should consider residential land uses when appropriate. Residential uses include single family residences, two family residences, multi-family condominiums and apartments, and certain forms of institutional housing.
<b><u>RED STAR:</u> NEW COMMERCIAL</b>	Areas where the Village should consider commercial land uses when appropriate. Commercial uses include retail stores, banks, restaurants, offices, services, department stores, auto-related sales and service, and multi-tenant commercial structures.
<b><u>PURPLE STAR:</u> NEW MIXED USE</b>	Areas where the Village should consider mixed use development and land uses. Mixed Use development includes a combination of residential, commercial, and office uses and often suggests a higher density.
<b><u>BLACK STAR:</u> NEW LIGHT INDUSTRIAL / BUSINESS PARK</b>	Areas where the Village should consider light industrial land uses when appropriate. Light industrial uses range from warehousing to more intensive indoor manufacturing and business parks.
<b><u>BROWN DOT:</u> MISCELLANEOUS</b>	Miscellaneous or other uses. Please use the comment area to describe your idea for any other land uses in more detail.
<b><u>RED LINE:</u></b>	New Road Connections/Extensions/Widening.
<b><u>GREEN LINE:</u></b>	New or extended Bicycle and Pedestrian Trails/Paths/Lanes.
