Mr. Yauck stated the engineering plans for the stormwater in the area would assist in determining what vegetation is best suited.

Chairperson Walny questioned how they planned to take the current drawings and build the development.

Mr. Yauck stated the current plan would be to have a multi-year project with the first building being the Library.

Commissioner Krampf questioned if there were plans for other amenities in the area such as a splash pad or soccer field.

Mr. Yauck stated the plan was to make this a legacy place for the residents of Bayside.
