

Department of Public Works October 2020

Highlights / Accomplishments

- DPW completed line stripping and stencil painting on Village Roadways.
- Crews completed two leaf collections in October with 459 stops producing around 225 yards of leaves.
- The final touches to the road resurfacing project was completed by the contractor, shouldering and and grass restoration was completed.
- Glass Shields were installed in Village Hall and IT offices. Work continues for the glass install project in the Bayside Communication Center.
- DPW completed an over excavated ditch and an out of network culvert replacement for residents.
- Six new touchless faucets were installed in the Village Hall and Police building.
- Crews completed annual street crack filling throughout the village covering approximately 5 miles of roadway
- Monthly Lift station Maintenance was performed. No issues were found. The Lift station Rehabilitation project has started. Work will continue over the next few months.

The adopt-a-tree program trees were ordered and planted.
