Highlights / Accomplishments

- The DPW crew worked hard on tree removals throughout the month, bringing the total trees removed to 78 to date.
- Final testing was completed onsite at Hermitage, Bay Point and the Lake Drive lift stations working out final nuisances in the monitoring system and control panels bringing this lift station rehab project to a close.
- The DPW crew helped ready the board room for the election, after the election was held, crews removed all voting items for future carpet and updates.
- The second annual salt take back event was launched. Disposal containers were placed at the Village's Police Department lobby to give residence a place to dispose of unused sidewalk and driveway salt.
- The crew completed the construction and installations of a central recycling center in the Village Hall lobby where residents are able to dispose of plastic bags and paper shredding.
- The tennis courts at Ellsworth Park were opened to the public following the winter season.
