Happy 10 Year Anniversary BCC!

10 years ago today, the Bayside Communications Center began accepting 911, emergency, and non-emergency calls for service for the Villages of Bayside, Brown Deer, Fox Point, River Hills, Shorewood, and Whitefish Bay; City of Glendale, and North Shore Fire Department. This collaborative effort consolidated three dispatch centers in the North Shore into one center.

The leadership, foresight, and collaboration over 10 years ago continues to enhance public safety services in the North Shore daily. While processing well over 1 million calls for services in the last 10 years, the Bayside Communications Center has reduced call processing times by nearly 1 minute, expediting public safety services to emergencies that much faster. Thank you to the team at BCC for what you do each day, every day!

Assessment Letters and Open Book

Properties which have received a change in property value, will receive a letter indicating so on or around June 1.

Open Book is scheduled for June 14 from 1-3 pm via telephone. If you cannot make it at this time, make an appointment using one of the following:

Note, assessed values may increase or decrease each year depending on recent market conditions. Your assessed value doesn't directly correlate to a change in the amount you pay for property taxes. Your assessment is based on the value of all buildings and land on your parcel as of January 1st, each year. Assessors must

follow state statutes to set fair and equitable values. Your new value is based on valid sales, from the prior year, that occur in your area.



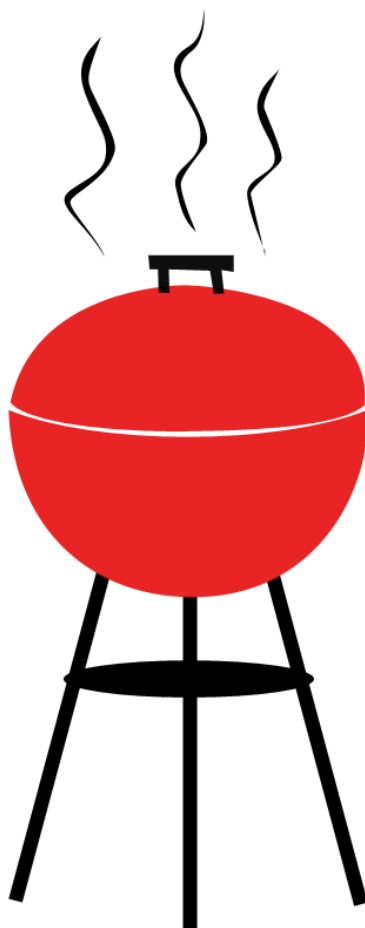
Village Offices Closed

Weekend Safety Tips

The Village hopes everyone has a safe and fun holiday weekend. Please remember the following:



- **Having an outdoor fire?** Bonfire are permitted provided that the fire is confined by a control device, structure, or other device specifically design for that use such as a fire pit, masonry barbeque pit, chimenea, outdoor fireplaced, or similar.
- **Firing up the grill?** Keep your grill away from any siding, deck rails, and eaves; clean your grill after each use; open your gas grill before lighting; never use a gas-fired grill inside any structure (even your garage).
- **Going swimming/boating?** Wear life jackets in and around natural bodies of water; secure the perimeter of your pool, never swim alone, watch any children closely.
- **Thinking of fireworks?** Fireworks are not permitted in the Village except for sparklers, paper caps, and toy snakes.

Welcome Captain Liebenthal!

Chief Doug Larsson is pleased to announce that Shorewood Police Captain Thomas A. Liebenthal will be joining the



Bayside Police Department as Captain of Police. Captain Liebenthal was selected by the Public Safety Committee after successfully completing a competitive process that attracted candidates from Illinois and Wisconsin.

Captain Liebenthal began his career with the Milwaukee County Sheriff's Office in 1996 where he served as a Deputy for 7 years. He was promoted to Detective in 2003 and again to Sergeant in 2005 until 2014. In 2014 he was hired by the Village of Shorewood as a Lieutenant and served until he was again promoted to the rank of Deputy Chief (Captain) in 2020. He was the Interim Chief of Police for 8 months until May of this year.

Captain Liebenthal has extensive experience in training, supervision and management, investigations, and working with the community where he gained respect as an empathetic listener and problem solver. He holds a Bachelor of Science degree in criminal justice from UW-Milwaukee (1993) and graduated the Northwestern University School of Police Staff and Command (2007).

Captain Liebenthal will start with the Village of Bayside on June 6th when he will take his Oath of Office.

What to look out for: Scams often start with unsolicited phone calls offering products aimed at easing a person's fears. Calls such as these were at the heart of a case in which a company contacted seniors (even those listed on the national Do Not Call registry) to hawk medical-alert pendants.

The company shipped products without getting an order and threatened legal action or verbally abused seniors who didn't pay.

Risks: Victims lose the cost of the product and could be exposed to identity theft.
