Election Results


45.15% of registered voters voted in Bayside on Election Day. To view Bayside only results, visit the Village <u>website</u>.

Grazing Goats Are Finishing Up

The Village has partnered with Grazing Goats Wisconsin, utilizing goats to clear approximately 3.5 acres of stormwater management facilities near the North Shore Fire Department on Brown Deer Road in Bayside.

The goats are located on private property behind a low voltage fence. The goats and fence should not be touched. From time to time, you may see Village Staff or Grazing Goats staff by the goats, however the public should not enter the gated area.

As these goats are working hard over the next few weeks, we kindly ask that motorists do not park vehicles in the North Shore Fire/Rescue parking lot (665 E. Brown Deer Rd.) or on Brown Deer Road to view the goats or trespass into the bioretention pond area where the goats are grazing.

Mailbox Replacement Program

Is your mailbox straight, stable, and sturdy? Does your mailbox need to be replaced? The Department of Public Works will replace your old or damaged mailbox with a new mailbox consisting of 1 standard black box and 1 standard wood post at a cost of \$200. To request a mailbox replacement, visit Access Bayside and fill out a <u>service request</u>. Payment can be made online or in person at Village Hall. Payment must be made prior to installation.

Mailboxes are installed to USPS standards. Mailboxes come with a 1-year warranty from date of purchase.



Do Not Solicit List

The <u>Do Not Solicit List</u> is a list of addresses where individuals who are going door to door are not permitted to sell products or services.

We also plant trees, use native plants in our landscaping, and construct bioswales to move rain water away from buildings and infrastructure to locations where the water can be treated by natural processes before returning to rivers and lakes.
