



## Congratulations Chief Liebenthal!

The Village of Bayside is pleased to announce the appointment of Bayside Police Captain Tom Liebenthal as the next Police Chief for the Village of Bayside.

Chief Liebenthal began his career with the Milwaukee County Sheriff's Office in 1996 where he served as a Deputy for 7 years. He was promoted to Detective in 2003 and again to Sergeant in 2005 until 2014. In 2014 he was hired by the Village of Shorewood as a Lieutenant and served until he was again promoted to the rank of Deputy Chief (Captain) in 2020. Chief Liebenthal also served as Interim Chief of Police for the Village of Shorewood.

Chief Liebenthal has extensive experience in training, supervision and management, investigations, and working with the community where he gained respect as an empathetic listener and problem solver. He holds a Bachelor of Science degree in criminal justice from UW-Milwaukee (1993) and graduated the Northwestern University School of Police Staff and Command (2007).

## Mailbox Replacement Program

Is your mailbox straight, stable, and sturdy? Does your mailbox need to be replaced? The Department of Public Works will replace your old or damaged mailbox with a new mailbox consisting of 1 standard black box and 1 standard wood post at a cost of \$200. To request a mailbox replacement, visit Access Bayside and fill out a [service request](#). Payment can be made online or in person at Village Hall. Payment must be made prior to installation.

Mailboxes are installed to USPS standards. Mailboxes come with a 1-year warranty from date of purchase.

## Display Your Permit



Completing a home project that requires a permit? SAFEbuilt, the Village's inspection company, will be mailing you a copy of your issued permit with a permit number on it. Please be sure to have your permit posted in your front window while the project is being completed!

### SUBSTANCE MISUSE

**What are opioids?** Opioids are substances that work in the nervous system of the body or in specific receptors in the brain to reduce the intensity of pain.

**What is fentanyl?** Fentanyl is a lab created (synthetic) opioid approved for treating severe pain (typically advanced cancer pain), in the form of transdermal patches or lozenges.

*It is 50 to 100 times more potent than morphine.*

#### PREVENT OVERDOSE DEATHS



Despite progress, drug overdose deaths continue to impact our nation.

**92,000** in 2021

- The majority involved a prescription or illicit opioid.
- Taking more than one drug at the same time can increase overdose risk.

**Not all overdoses have to end in death.**

**Everyone has a role to play.**

- Learn about the risks of opioids.
- Learn about naloxone, its availability, and how to use it.
- Help people struggling with opioid use disorder find the right care and treatment.

In Milwaukee County, from January 2022 to June 2022:

- 211 confirmed fatal overdoses
- 2270 suspected nonfatal overdoses have been reported

Nationwide, overdose deaths involving fentanyl and fentanyl analogs, rates increased over 56% from 2019 to 2020.
