## **Emergency Medical Dispatching**

Emergency Medical Dispatch (EMD) is the essential initial point of contact for callers seeking medical assistance, providing a combination of telecommunication skills and medical instruction. EMD initiates and coordinates the most appropriate emergency medical service response while providing medical assistance to callers over the phone until help arrives.

EMD uses a protocol reference system which is the single-most valuable tool for processing medical calls. EMD reference cards help to determine which questions to ask, resources to dispatch and pre-arrival instructions to provide. The use of standardized and medically approved EMD cards makes the provision of medical information by phone consistent and accurate, delivering accurate information, in the same manner, every time.

Each 911 call will begin with these four questions:

- What is the address of the emergency?
- What is the phone number you are calling from?
- What is your name?
- Ok, tell me exactly what happened?

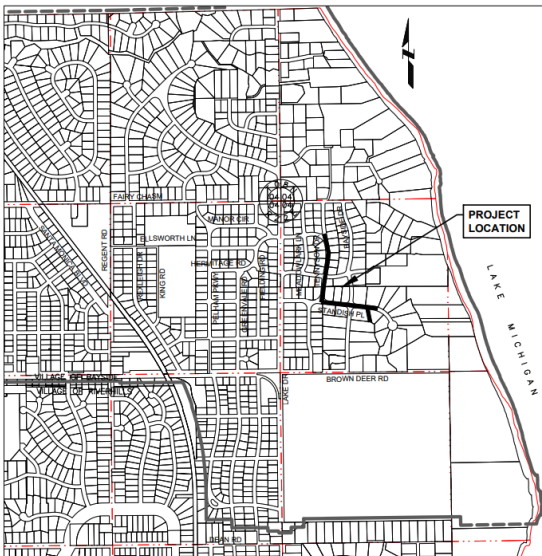
## Bayside Five and Wine

## Fish Creek Project

MMSD currently has jurisdiction of Fish Creek for the purpose of studying stormwater impacts addressing structures that are at risk of flooding.

The purpose of this project is to reduce the risk of flooding along Fish Creek in the Village of Bayside while protecting an environmentally sensitive stream corridor downstream. The scope of the project consists of conducting a preliminary engineering study of Fish Creek to mitigate for current and future anticipated flood risks associated with additional runoff expected from land use changes in the watershed.

## Mailbox Replacement Program

Is your mailbox straight, stable, and sturdy? Does your mailbox need to be replaced? The Department of Public Works will replace your old or damaged mailbox with a new mailbox consisting of 1 standard black box and 1 standard wood post at a cost of \$200.

To request a mailbox replacement, visit Access Bayside and fill out a [service request](#). Payment can be made online or in person at Village Hall. Payment must be made prior to installation.

Mailboxes are installed to USPS standards. Mailboxes come with a 1-year warranty from date of purchase.



## Sanitary Sewer Lining and Manhole Rehabilitation Project

Visu-Sewer will be cleaning and televising the sewer mains beginning August 29. The lining installation began this week. There are approximately 10,000 feet of main line and approximately 60 manholes that are included in the project.

Residents will begin to see blue Visu-Sewer trucks around the Village. Remember to keep toilet lids down during this process.

### MONKEYPOX VACCINATION AT NORTH SHORE HEALTH DEPARTMENT

JYNNEOS vaccine is currently available for the following people:

- **Known contacts who are identified by public health through case investigation, contact tracing, and risk exposure assessments.**
- **Presumed contacts who may meet the following criteria:**
  - People who know that a sexual partner in the past 14 days was diagnosed with monkeypox.
  - People who attended an event or venue where there was known monkeypox exposure.
  - Gay men, bisexual men, trans men and women, any men who have sex with men, and gender non-conforming/non-binary people, who have had multiple sexual partners in the last 14 days.
- **People considered to have an elevated risk of exposure to monkeypox in the future:**
  - Gay men, bisexual men, trans men and women, any men who have sex with men, and gender non-conforming/non-binary people who expect to have multiple or anonymous sex partners. This may include people living with HIV and people who take HIV pre-exposure.
  - Some clinical laboratory personnel, research laboratory workers, and certain health care providers working in sexual health clinics.
