Yard Waste Collection

The next full yard waste collection will begin o Monday, October 3.

- Yard waste must be out before 7am on Monday, October 3 to ensure your items will be picked up.
- Yard waste must be at least 3 feet away from mailboxes and other structures, branches must be less than 5' long, branches must be parallel to the road, and cannot be in plastic bags.
- Yard waste should be placed in bags or containers if possible.
- If your pile is greater than 10' long x 5' wide x 5' high, you will need a special pick-up which can be requested here.

- Ink Cartridges
- Light bulbs
- Habitat for Humanity donations
- Goodwill donations
- Paint (Will need to empty paint into separate container at event)
- Scrap metal
- Yard waste
- Plastic bags
- Paper recycling (to be shredded offsite by third-party).
- Motor oil

To participate, residents must provide three (3) non-perishable items or a monetary donation for the Hunger Task Force.



November 8 Election Reminders

For any voter that has a request on file for the November 8 Election, absentee ballots will be mailed on Thursday, September 22, 2022.

Voters who choose to vote by mail need to ensure the envelope has the witness <u>signature and address</u> in full in addition to the voter signature. Please be sure to follow the instructions included with your ballot in full. The Village Clerk's office is not able to make any correction to the envelope on your behalf.

In-person absentee voting will occur on weekdays from Tuesday, October 25, 2022, to Friday, November 4, 2022, during regular business hours (Monday through Friday, 8:00am to 4:00pm, until 5:00pm on Friday, November 4, 2022).

You can register to vote and request an absentee ballot online at https://myvote.wi.gov/en-us/. October 19 is the deadline to register to vote by mail or online.

Port Washington Road Traffic Shift

WisDOT's County Line Interchange project will include a traffic shift on Port Washington Road beginning this week between the Elizabeth Residence and Ravine Lane.

The shift will take the existing northbound and southbound lanes and narrow them to 10 feet (20 feet total) to provide room to rebuild the future southbound lanes of Port Washington Road. Due to the reduced width, the speed limit will reduce to 25mph.

Tennyson Drive Storm Sewer Project

Building on previously installed Green Infrastructure Improvements, the Tennyson Drive Stormwater Management Infrastructure Project will address localized flooding during significant storm events and allow stormwater from the drainage basin to collect and direct runoff to the ravine located near Standish Place, southeast of the Tennyson Drive area of concern that currently experiences flooding.

Fish Creek Project

MMSD currently has jurisdiction of Fish Creek for the purpose of studying stormwater impacts addressing structures that are at risk of flooding.

The purpose of this project is to reduce the risk of flooding along Fish Creek in the Village of Bayside while protecting an environmentally

sensitive stream corridor downstream. The scope of the project consists of conducting a preliminary engineering study of Fish Creek to mitigate for current and future anticipated flood risks associated with additional runoff expected from land use changes in the watershed.

Sanitary Sewer Lining and Manhole Rehabilitation Project

Visu-Sewer will be cleaning and televising the sewer mains beginning August 29. The lining installation began this week. There are approximately 10,000 feet of main line and approximately 60 manholes that are included in the project.

Residents will begin to see blue Visu-Sewer trucks around the Village. Remember to keep toilet lids down during this process.

Mailbox Replacement Program

Is your mailbox straight, stable, and sturdy? Does your mailbox need to be replaced? The Department of Public Works will replace your old or damaged mailbox with a new mailbox consisting of 1 standard black box and 1 standard wood post at a cost of \$200.

To request a mailbox replacement, visit Access Bayside and fill out a <u>service</u> request. Payment can be made online or in person at Village Hall. Payment must be made prior to installation.

Mailboxes are installed to USPS standards. Mailboxes come with a 1-year warranty from date of purchase.

MONKEYPOX VACCINATION AT NORTH SHORE HEALTH DEPARTMENT

JYNNEOS vaccine is currently available for the following people:

- Known contacts who are identified by public health through case investigation, contact tracing, and risk exposure assessments.
- Presumed contacts who may meet the following criteria:
 People who know that a sexual partner in the past 14 days was diagnosed.
- with monkeypox.

 People who attended an event or venue where there was known monkeypox
- exposure.

 Gay men, bisexual men, trans men and women, any men who have sex with men, and gender non-conforming/non-binary people, who have had multiple sexual partners in the last 14 days.
- People considered to have an elevated risk of exposure to
- monkeypox in the future:

 Gay men, bisexual men, trans men and women, any men who have sex with men, and gender non-conforming/non-binary people who expect to have multiple or anonymous sex partners. This may include people living with HIV and people who take HIV pre-exposure.

 Some clinical laboratory personnel, research laboratory workers, and certain health care providers working in sexual health clinics.
