Yard Waste Collection

The next full yard waste collection will begin on Monday, November 14.

- Yard waste must be out before 7am to ensure your items will be picked up.
- Yard waste must be at least 3 feet away from structures.
- Branches must be less than 5' long.
- Branches must be parallel to the road, and cannot be in plastic bags.
- Yard waste should be placed in bags or containers, if possible.

 Piles greater than 10' long x 5' wide x 5' high require a <u>fee-based special</u> <u>pick-up</u>.

Recycling Day is scheduled for November 19 from 9-11:30am in the Public Works parking lot. Residents should enter off Fairy Chasm and will be able to dispose of:

- Recycling
- Yard waste
- Electronics
- Scrap metal
- Plastic bags
- Light bulbs
- Textiles
- Paper
- Ink cartridges
- Eye glasses
- Cell phones

Please note, if the item is not listed above, it will NOT be accepted. Garbage and the following electronic items are not accepted (TVs, monitors, refrigerators, dehumidifiers, and other items that contain freon).


- Gently used and new coats in all sizes, from tots to adults, are appreciated.

- All coats will be cleaned and distributed in Milwaukee-area schools by the Salvation Army.




Diabetes Awareness Month
