In-Person Absentee Voting

In-person absentee voting will occur on weekdays from Tuesday, October 25, 2022, to Friday, November 4, 2022, during regular business hours (Monday through Friday, 8:00am to 4:00pm, until 5:00pm on Friday, November 4, 2022).

Wednesday, October 19 was the deadline to register by mail or online for the November 8 General Election. You will need to register in-person at the Clerk's office (Village Hall, 9075 N. Regent Road) or at the polls on Election Day.

Visit MyVote to:

- Register To Vote
- Update your voter information (name or address)
- Request an absentee ballot -Thursday, November 3
- Find your polling location
- View a sample ballot

Absentee ballots can be returned in-person at the Clerk's office, mailed back using the provided envelope, or brought to your polling location on Election Day.

Voters who choose to vote by mail need to

ensure the envelope has the witness signature and address in full in addition to the voter signature. Please be sure to follow the instructions included with your ballot in full. The Village Clerk's office is not able to make any correction to the envelope on your behalf.



Election Day

The General Election will be held on Tuesday, November 8. The polls will be open from 7am to 8pm. Bayside residents have one (1) polling location - 9075 N Regent Rd, Bayside, WI: Village Hall Board Room. All voters will enter through the front door of Village Hall.

All voters must have a photo ID when voting. Acceptable forms of photo ID can be found here.

If you are registering to vote on Election Day, you must provide photo ID and <u>Proof</u> of Residence.

If you are returning your absentee ballot on Election Day, please bring it to the Clerk's Office, not to the polling room.

Pumpkin Disposal


It is important to keep organic material, such as pumpkins, out of the waste stream! There are 3 options for disposing of pumpkins this fall:
