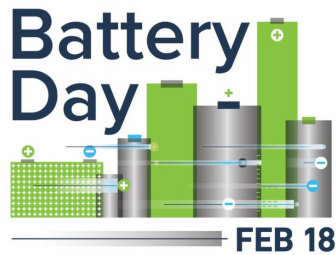
### Mount Bayside Parking

## No Mow May

No Mow May is a conservation initiative that encourages people to stop mowing or mow less often for the month of May to create habitat and provide resources for bees and other early-season pollinators. The Village of Bayside is proud to join a number of other municipalities in the No Mow May initiative.

During the month of May, Bayside will suspend enforcement of long-grass rules, allowing property owners to delay or reduce lawn cutting to promote pollinator-friendly habitat early in the growing season.



Participating residents must register their properties.

1. Installing barriers between birds and the window exterior
2. Breaking up reflections that birds see in windows
3. Removing the illusion of a clear passageway
4. Turning off or down-shielding outdoor lighting
