Also known as African American History Month, the event grew out of "Negro History Week," the brainchild of noted historian Carter G. Woodson and other prominent African Americans. Since 1976, every U.S. president has officially designated the month of February as Black History Month.

During Black history month and every month, advocating for minority health and health equity is critical. Minority health is impacted by social and structural factors that drive disparities in our society. Promoting equitable access to health promoting resources, including quality housing, healthy food, stable employment, etc., can help decrease gaps in health between racial and ethnic groups.

- 4. Turning off or down-shielding outdoor lighting




