# **Brown Deer Road Construction Update**

Beginning the week of January 30, MMSD will resume work on the Brown Deer Road sanitary sewer project.

Beginning the week of the January 30, the long term closure of Brown Deer Road will commence and be closed in both directions from Regent Road to Bayside Garden Center. Southbound Regent Road, south of Brown Deer Road, will also be closed. MMSD will be publishing official detour routes in the coming days.

Bayside Garden Center will be accessible from the east. North Shore Detailing will be accessible from the west on Regent Road. All businesses will be accessible during the duration of the MMSD project.

## **Salt Brine Coming Soon**

This week is Wisconsin Salt Awareness Week, and the Village of Bayside is committed to providing efficient usage of salt to maintain safe roads throughout the winter.

The Department of Public Works is currently working on implementing a new salt brine application system.

Salt brine works as a pre-treatment on roads prior to a snowfall, preventing the snow from bonding to the surface and speeding up the melting process. The pre-application of brine means less salt is used to keep roads clear.

Property tax bills were mailed December 6.






