



2023 Adopt-A-Tree

The Adopt-A-Tree program is back with two options in 2023.

Option 1: Public Right-of-Way Trees

 The cost per tree is \$200, and includes 1 tree, planting in public right-of-way, mulching, & initial watering.

Option 2: Private Property Trees

 The cost per tree is \$225, and only includes the tree. Trees can be planted on private property.

In the continued effort to maintain a 5% species threshold and to diversify the Village's tree population, the following trees will be available this year:

- Japanese Tree Lilac
- Imperial Honeylocust
- Exclamation Planetree
- American Sweetgum

Sign up will begin soon, request your Adopt-A-Tree by Friday, May 5 to participate in the 2023 program.

MMSD Pipe Check Program

The MMSD Pipe Check Program provides residents a financial incentive to eliminate sources of clear water entering the sanitary sewer system. Excess clear water in the sanitary sewer system increases the risk for basement backups for yourself and your neighbors during rain events.

Mailbox Replacement Program

Is your mailbox straight, stable, and sturdy? Does your mailbox need to be replaced? The Department of Public Works will replace your old or damaged mailbox with a new mailbox consisting of 1 standard black box and 1 standard wood post at a cost of \$200.

To request a mailbox replacement, visit Access Bayside and fill out a service request. Payment can be made online or in person at Village Hall. Payment must be made prior to installation.

Mailboxes are installed to USPS standards. Mailboxes come with a 1-year warranty from date of purchase.

No Mow May

No Mow May is a conservation initiative that encourages people to stop mowing or mow less often for the month of May to create habitat and provide resources for bees and other early-season pollinators. The Village of Bayside is proud to join a number of other municipalities in the No Mow May initiative.

During the month of May, Bayside will suspend enforcement of long-grass rules, allowing property owners to delay or reduce lawn cutting to promote pollinator-friendly habitat early in the growing season. Participating residents must register their properties.

To become a 2023 No Mow May participant, Bayside residents must register through Access bayside no later than May 7, 2023.

MMSD Rain Garden Plant Sale




