# MMSD Brown Deer Road Project Update

The contractor for the Milwaukee Metropolitan Sewage District (MMSD) on Brown Deer Road encountered unexpected conditions that will delay the completion of the sewer project by 12 days, until August 23.

The issue encountered is located at the intersection of Regent Road and Brown Deer Road. While all parties were aware of numerous utility conflicts that posed significant challenge for the project, the contractor encountered an additional 7 feet of solid concrete at a depth of 45 feet below the road where work is occurring on the existing sewer main. The additional 7 feet of concrete has posed significant challenges and delay in the work, particularly due to the depth of the work being performed. The remaining aspects of the project continue to progress as anticipated.

The contractor continues to work as

expeditiously and safely as possible to complete the project.

# Bayside Communications Center receives Milwaukee County Primary PSAP Designation

The Intergovernmental Cooperation Council (ICC), which is composed of the village president and mayor from each of the municipalities in Milwaukee County, plus the County Executive, was assigned by the Wisconsin State Legislature, through Act 26 to designate one Primary Safety Answering Point (PSAP), or Emergency Dispatch Center, for Milwaukee County. One of the main components of the primary PSAP designation is access to State grant funding.

Current grant funding per designated PSAP is up to \$500,000 annually and is anticipated to increase in future years, as funds for this program are collected through a monthly charge on each cell phone in the State of Wisconsin. Once designated, the primary PSAP designation remains in perpetuity. Grant funding will assist in implementing Next Generation 911 technologies, emergency dispatch mandates, implement new innovative approaches and measures that will improve emergency response times, enhance public safety communications, and provide the highest level of support to those in need during critical situations.

The ICC studied this issue for approximately the past 18 months, including the creation of a study committee to provide a recommendation on the PSAP. The Study committee concluded that the Village of Bayside, Milwaukee County and City of Milwaukee were all qualified to be the primary PSAP, but did not make a recommendation.

At the meeting of the Intergovernmental Cooperation Council (ICC) on Monday, July 10, the ICC voted to designate the Bayside Communications Center (BCC), which serves Bayside, Brown Deer, Fox Point, Glendale, River Hills, Shorewood, Whitefish Bay, and the North Shore Fire Department, as the designated Primary Safety Answering Point (PSAP) for Milwaukee County. BCC was selected over both the City of Milwaukee and Milwaukee County.

This designation is of significant honor and benefit to the Village of Bayside, Bayside Communications Center, and all of our partners within the North Shore. Numerous people worked collectively and tirelessly to achieve this designation. Village President Walny, Bayside Communications Director Scharnott, Information Technology Director Foscato, and North Shore Fire Chief Whitaker all deserve special recognition.



# **East Side Sewer Relief Project**

To assist with managing large storm events, the East Bayside Sanitary Sewer Relief System project evaluates and seeks to develop additional sanitary sewer



capacity for the area bounded by East Bay Point Road to the north, North Bayside Drive to the east, East Hermitage Road to the south, and North Lake Drive to the west. The project consists of developing a new sanitary sewer relief system, which will extend and connect to another sanitary sewer relief to the intersection of Lake Drive and Manor Circle.

Construction is beginning this week. The project will take approximately 6-7 weeks and be completed around September 15. Effected properties will receive correspondence throughout the duration of the project.

#### **Dial 988**

Sunday, July 16 marked one year of the 988 Suicide & Crisis Lifeline being a safe place for anyone experiencing thoughts of suicide, a mental health or substance use crisis, or any other kind of emotional distress.

Most calls, texts, and chats to 988 from Wisconsin-based phone numbers and locations are answered by trained counselors who work for the 988 Wisconsin Lifeline, which is operated by Family Services of Northeast Wisconsin under a grant from the Division of Care and Treatment Services.

From July 2022 through June 2023, the 988 Wisconsin Lifeline received 91,834 contacts, far exceeding initial projections. Over 98% of the contacts were resolved through the conversation, reducing pressures on the state's system of emergency services for mental health and substance use concerns.


