### Back to School

It's almost time to head back to school! Start the school year out on the right foot by discussing the safety tips below with your children.

- If you walk or bike to school, use designated crosswalks and follow

# Back to School Safety



- traffic rules.
- Wear reflective gear or bright clothing if it's dark outside.
- If you take the bus, wait in a safe location away from traffic and follow the bus driver's instructions.
- Teach children to never talk to strangers or accept rides from anyone without your permission.
- Set up a safe word that only you and your child know in case someone else needs to pick them up unexpectedly.
- Teach kids about food allergies, both their own and their classmates', to avoid sharing unsafe foods.
- Make sure your child is up-to-date on vaccinations and yearly check-ups.
- Encourage regular handwashing to prevent the spread of germs.
- Provide the school with updated emergency contact information and inform them of any relevant health conditions or allergies your child has.
- Teach your child about bullying, its forms, and how to report it to teachers or school authorities.
