Recycling Day will be held on September 16 from 9-11:30am. Bayside residents can dispose of yard waste, recycling, electronics, scrap metal, plastic bags, ink cartridges, eyeglasses, cell phones, and textiles. Please enter off Fairy Chasm Road.

BACK TO SCHOOL ROAD SAFETY TIPS

With back-to-school upon us, we would like to share important reminders to keep all those who travel Village streets safe.

Share the Road with Pedestrians:

- When stopped in a vehicle at an intersection, such as N. Port Washington Road and W. Brown Deer Road, be sure to be stopped behind the white stop line so you are not blocking the crosswalk.
- Pedestrians should always wait for the signal to cross the street.
- On N. Pelham Parkway and N. Regent Road at E. Brown Deer Road, press the walk button to activate the flashing lights, grab the orange flag, then wait for a safe time to cross the street.
- Vehicles in both directions must yield to pedestrians in a crosswalk if not on a divided highway.

Share the Road with Bicycles

- Vehicles must leave at least a three feet clearance when passing bicycles.
- During hours of darkness, bicycles must have a white front headlight and a red rear light or red rear reflector.
- Bicyclists are encouraged to use the bicycle lanes on N. Lake Drive, N. Port Washington Road, and E. Brown Deer Road. Vehicles are not allowed to travel in the bicycle lane unless making a turn.

Share the Road with Buses

- When a school bus activates its flashing red lights, vehicles in both directions must stop at least 20 feet from the school bus.
- Give a safe following distance and be alert for children darting across the road after getting off the bus.
- When amber flashing lights are activated, this means the school bus will be coming to a stop shortly. Vehicles are allowed to cautiously continue past the bus as the amber lights are flashing but should be prepared to stop.

PRESCRIPTION DRUG DROP OFF

The Bayside Police Department accepts old or unused medicine 24 hours a day, seven days a week in the Police Department lobby. Accepted items include:

- Prescription and over-the-counter medications
- Ointments
- Sprays
- Inhalers
- Creams
- Vials
- Pet medicine

Please do not dispose of needles/sharps, biohazardous material (items containing bodily fluid or blood), personal care products (shampoo, soaps, etc.), or household hazardous waste.

KEEP CULVERTS CLEAN

Summer means more yard waste by driveways and culverts. Keep your culvert clean by removing debris obstructions to prevent backups and blockages and allow stormwater to flow smoothly.

MAILBOX REPLACEMENT PROGRAM

Is your mailbox straight, stable and sturdy? Does your mailbox need to be replaced? The Department of Public Works will replace your old or damaged mailbox with a new mailbox consisting of one standard black box and one standard wood post at a cost of \$200. To request a mailbox replacement, visit Access Bayside and fill out a service request. Payment can be made online or in person at Village Hall. Payment must be made prior to installation. Mailboxes are installed to USPS standards. Mailboxes come with a one-year warranty from date of purchase.
