### 2023 Road Project

The 2023 Road Project being completed in the Apple Orchard neighborhood has began the road resurfacing stage.



The paving contractor has begun pulverizing the existing pavement. Shaping the base of the road will take place Friday, September 8 through September 13. The new asphalt pavement will be laid being September 14 through September 18. Laying of stone shoulder and landscape restoration will follow. Staff will work with residents to ensure they can exit and enter their driveway as necessary.

Milwaukee Area Domestic Animal Control Commission (MADACC) will only be accepting sick and injured stray cats in need of immediate medical attention from Thursday, August 31, through close of business Friday, September 8, 2023, to manage the health of the cats in their care. Due to the unprecedented intake numbers for both cats and dogs that MADACC has been experiencing for several months, the cases of feline panleukopenia in their cat population have increased. Feline panleukopenia is a disease caused by the feline parvovirus.

Thank you to everyone who donated blood on Thursday, August 24th at the Village Hall Blood Drive.

Results from the day include:

- Registered Donors/Signed-In: 23 total registered donors.
- **Deferrals**: 1 deferral
- Whole Blood Collected: 16 whole blood units collected.
- Dual Red Blood Collected: 12 dual red units collected (6 donors x 2 double the impact)

Through the 28 units collected, over 84 local patients will be impacted. Thank you!

## **Drug Take Back Day**

Too often, unused and unwanted medications find their way into the wrong hands. That's dangerous and often tragic. Bringing unused and unwanted medications to a Drug Take Back Day collection site protects you, your family, and your community.

In April of 2023, Wisconsin ranked number one throughout the country for the most prescription medications collected during the spring 2023 Drug Take Back. Wisconsin collected 55,472 lbs. of unwanted medications this spring.

The next Drug Take Back Day will be held on October 28, 2023 at the Bayside Police Department Lobby.

### Acceptable Items:

- Prescription and over-the-counter medications
- Ointments
- Sprays
- Inhalers
- Creams
- Vials
- Pet medication

### Unacceptable Items:

- Needles/sharps
- Items containing bodily fluid or blood
- · Personal care products
- Household hazardous waste
