



Leaf Collection

The next leaf collection will begin on Monday, November 6.

Leaves should be on the shoulder of the road - not in the ditch and not in the street. This practice is not only for collection purposes, but maintains safety and keeps stormwater clean!

Pumpkins can also be placed in loose leaf piles, but all other yard waste should be kept separate.

The best fertilizer is already in your yard! Mulch your loose leaves and use them as fertilizer in your yard.

Pumpkin Disposal

You have 3 options for disposing of pumpkins this fall:

- 1. Place in your yard waste pile.
- 2. Place in your leaf pile.
- 3. Bring to the pumpkin disposal carts at Village Hall from October 30 to November 30.

It is important to keep organic material, such as pumpkins, our of the waste stream.

This is also a great time to change the batteries in your smoke alarms!




Yard Waste Collection

The next full yard waste collection will begin on Monday, November 13.

- Yard waste must be out before 7am on Monday, October 30 to ensure your items will be picked up.
- Yard waste must be at least 3 feet away from mailboxes and other structures, branches must be less than 5' long, branches must be parallel to the road, and cannot be in plastic bags.
- Yard waste should be placed in bags or yard waste carts if possible.
- If your pile is greater than 10' long x 5' wide x 5' high, you will need a special pick-up which can be requested <u>here</u>.


