Special Needs Registry



BUILDING THE BOND -- ONE STREET AT A TIME

The Village of Bayside Police Department recognizes that some members of our community may have special needs, or may react differently when coming into contact with police officers or firefighters during an emergency situation. With this in mind, we've created a Special Needs Registry.

The Special Needs Registry is available for all residents requiring special needs resulting from a physical, emotional, or medical condition (i.e. dementia, autism, etc.). Information provided is maintained in a confidential database which will assist emergency responders in providing a more informed response to those with special needs during an emergency. New Plastic Bag Compactor

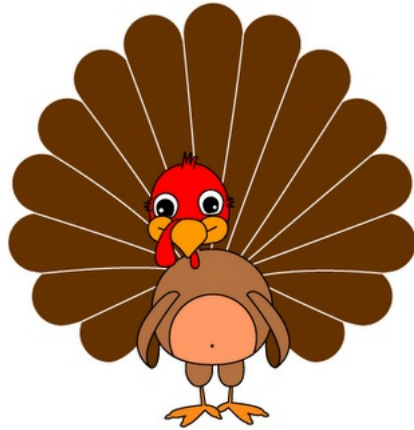


Available now is a compactor that you can now use to dispose of your plastic bags. It is located to the left of the drop box outside of the main Village Hall entrance. You can still drop off plastic bags inside Village Hall at the Recycling Center, but this will give you the opportunity to drop off bags outside of business hours and still have them properly recycled!

The compactor does have a smaller opening shoot so please make sure plastic

bags are not in large clumps when inserting them so that they can fit easily and do not jam the machine. Once inserted, the compactor will compact the plastic bags down and be ready for more! We ask that the compactor only be used for plastic bags – no garbage, recycling, or other miscellaneous waste.

Village Hall offices and the Department of Public Works will be closed on Thursday, November 23 and Friday, November 24 for Thanksgiving.

Garbage and recycling collection will not be effected.
