All loose leaves must be roadside by 7am on Monday, December 4 to ensure they get picked up.

Any remaining leaves or yard waste can be picked up by requesting a fee-based Special Pick-Up or brought to the Holiday Recycling Day on Wednesday, December 27 from 2-5pm.

Bayside Citizens Academy

The Bayside Citizens Academy is back after a successful first year in 2023!

The Bayside Citizens Academy is a



program offered to Bayside residents that aims to provide a closer look at the operations of local government and the jobs of those who work for the Village.

The Academy will be comprised of seven interactive learning sessions led by Village staff who will provide participants with an in-depth look at Village departments and operations including, but not limited to, police, fire and EMS, public works, emergency dispatching, elections, budgeting, property taxes, library, and health. Not only will participants learn about the operation, but also tour the facilities. Yes, that means spend time in jail, listen to 911 calls, sit in the garbage truck, and more.

Participants will navigate the program as a cohort, learning alongside fellow community members. Sessions will be held on specified Wednesday evenings from 6-8pm. The Village will hold a graduation reception at 5:45pm on Thursday, April 18 and a graduation ceremony at 6pm at that evening's Board of Trustees meeting.



Avoid Porch Pirates

Are you expecting package deliveries for the holidays? Follow these tips to keep your packages safe from porch pirates.

- Have packages delivered to your work.
- Have your package delivered to the home of a relative or friend that you know will be home.
- Have your package held at your local post office for pickup.
- Take advantage of "Ship to Store" option that many stores offer. Amazon offers a "locker" feature that allows you to pick up your package from a secure location.
- Request signature confirmation.
- Ask your carrier to place packages out of view of the street.



Don't Throw Snow

As you or your contractor are clearing snow from your driveway, please be sure to only deposit snow on the property from which it was removed.

Depositing snow on another property or in the road will leave you responsible for removal and subject to a municipal citation.

As the snow starts to fall, don't forget to head over to Mount Bayside! All are



welcome to the sled hill located north of Village Hall at 9075 North Regent Road.

Parking is available in the lot behind the sled hill. Please do not park on the street or block the driveway. Overflow parking is available in the parking lot south of Village Hall.



North Shore East Median Restoration Project

The North Shore East neighborhood median will see a new life beginning this winter! Located at the intersection of Fairy Chasm Road and Broadmoor Road, the current median has failing side walls and stormwater management issues which are not repairable and present a safety hazard.

During the week of December 4, the DPW will begin removing the current vegetation and deconstructing the current walls. The following week, the Department will begin building the foundation for the new walls and install the first layer of the new lannon stone wall.

The walls will not be completed until March when we begin to experience more mild weather. Come spring, new plants and trees will be planted, bringing the project to completion.

As construction takes place, please yield to crews and drive with caution in the area.
