



Sewer Jetting Begins Monday

Sewer jetting will be conducted in the area south of Fairy Chasm Road, east of Pelham Parkway, and north of Brown Deer Road beginning Monday, November 13.

The sanitary sewer main cleaning process uses high pressure water jetting in the sewer mains that may push water out of your residential plumbing floor traps and private plumbing fixtures. This happens most commonly when there is a problem with a home's plumbing vent. It will be most evident by the appearance of clean water ponding on the floor around floor drains or water levels rising inside of toilet bowls.

To prevent this, please pour tap water down all basement floor drains or rarely used sinks, tubs, or toilets to ensure that you do not have a dry sewer trap.



Yard Waste Collection

The next full yard waste collection will begin on Monday, November 13.

- Yard waste must be out before 7am on Monday, October 30 to ensure your items will be picked up.
- Yard waste must be at least 3 feet away from mailboxes and other structures, branches must be less than 5' long, branches must be parallel to the road, and cannot be in plastic bags.
- Yard waste should be placed in bags or yard waste carts if possible.
- If your pile is greater than 10' long x 5' wide x 5' high, you will need a special pick-up which can be requested <u>here</u>.

Leaf Collection

The next leaf collection will begin on Monday, November 20.

Leaves should be on the shoulder of the road - not in the ditch and not in the street. This practice is not only for collection purposes, but maintains safety and keeps stormwater clean!

Pumpkins can also be placed in loose leaf piles, but all other yard waste should be kept separate.
