- Paper greeting cards (no electronic/musical cards)
- Cartons (including empty eggnog cartons)
- Wrapping paper tube
- Paper based wrapping paper
- Normal recyclables

DO NOT put in your recycle bin:

- Metallic looking wrapping paper
- Bows or ribbons
- Christmas lights

- Bubble wrap
- Styrofoam
- Plastic bags





### 2024 Pet Licenses

2024 Dog and Cat Licenses are now available. Apply in person at Village Hall or online.

Licenses are required for pets aged five (5) months and older. Proof of current rabies vaccinations with the rabies certificate number and expiration date must be provided to issue the license.

Licenses must be renewed each year. The deadline to apply without an additional fee is March 31.

Tree collection will be performed as normal this year on the first and second Thursday of the year. Please have your trees roadside by 7am on January 4 or January 11 to have them collected. Trees should not be placed in bags and all items should be removed from trees.

### **Bayside Citizens Academy**

The Bayside Citizens Academy is a program offered to Bayside residents that aims to provide a closer look at the operations of local government and the jobs of those who work for the Village.

The Academy will be comprised of seven interactive learning sessions led by Village staff who will provide participants with an in-depth look at Village departments and operations including, but not limited to, police, fire and EMS, public works, emergency dispatching, elections, budgeting, property taxes, library, and health. Not only will participants learn about the operation, but also tour the facilities. Yes, that means spend time in jail, listen to 911 calls, sit in the garbage truck, and more.

Participants will navigate the program as a cohort, learning alongside fellow community members. Sessions will be held on specified Wednesday evenings from 6-8pm. The Village will hold a graduation reception at 5:45pm on Thursday, April 18 and a graduation ceremony at 6pm at that evening's Board of Trustees meeting.
