Holiday Tree Collection

The Village will be completing the final Christmas tree collection on Thursday, January 11.

- Place trees at the edge of the road by 7am.
- Do not place trees in plastic bags.



- No metal bracing of wreaths or garland.
- All items must be removed from trees.

Wipes Clog Pipes

Please be aware that baby and hand wipes marked as "flushable" should not be flushed down the drain or toilet! These wipes do not break down in water like regular toilet paper does and need to disposed of in the trash.

Please do not flush clothes, wipes, diapers, paper towels, or any other materials other than toilet paper down the drain or toilet.

The occurrence of these items in the Village sanitary sewer system can lead to backups in homes and Village infrastructure.



Smart Salting

You can keep sidewalks and driveways safe this winter while protecting our waters by following these simple steps:

- Shovel Clear walkways and other areas before the snow turns to ice. The more snow you remove manually, the less salt you will have to use and the more effective it will be.
- Scatter If you use salt, scatter it so that there is space between the grains. Believe it or not, a coffee mug of salt is enough to treat an entire 20-foot driveway or 10 sidewalk squares.
- 3. Switch When pavement temperatures drop below 15° F, salt won't work. Switch to sand for traction or a different ice melt that works at lower temperatures.

The Wisconsin Legislature Sales Tax

The Wisconsin Legislature authorized a sales tax increase for both the City of Milwaukee and Milwaukee County in 2023 Wisconsin Act 12.

Starting on January 1, 2024, the combined sales tax rate in the City of Milwaukee is 7.9% and 5.9% for the rest of Milwaukee County.

If you are a resident of the Village of Bayside and believe you were overcharged sales tax by any retailer, you are entitled to seek a refund from that retailer. Please save your receipt. Wisconsin law states that retailers who over collect sales tax must return the tax collected in error to their customers or remit to the Wisconsin Department of Revenue (DOR). Contact DOR to report any inaccurate sales tax collection. DOR will follow up on all reports of inaccurate sales tax collection.

What's the 211?



Winter Weather Reminders

When it's times for plows to hit the roads, please help them out by remembering the following:

- Parking Restrictions: Vehicles should not park on Village streets.
- Slow Down: Drive slow, use caution, and leave plenty of space between you, other drivers, and snow plows.
- Give Them Room: If you see plows out on the road, give them plenty of space. They make frequent stops, starts, and turns.
- Clear Hydrants: Remember to clear the snow around your fire hydrant so crews can easily access it if needed in an emergency.
- Depositing Snow: Please deposit snow on your property, not on Village streets or on a neighbor's property.
- Be Patient: During a snow storm, crews will be out working. They start with main streets and continue to clear all 46 lane miles and cul-desacs within the Village.
- Mount Bayside Parking: Please
 use the sled hill parking lot or Village
 Hall parking lot for sled hill parking.
 Use caution as DPW plows will be
 active in the area around the parking
 lots and streets.


