## **Prevent Snowmelt Flooding**

Snowmelt flooding happens when temperatures rise, rain starts to fall, and snow begins to melt, all while the ground is still frozen. The ground can't absorb melting snow and rain fast enough. With rain in the immediate forecast, these tips can help protect your property and the neighborhood.

- 1. Remove snow from your roof.
- 2. Remove snow 3-5 feet away from the base of your home.
- 3. Spread out large mounds of snow.
- Clear snow from your driveway culvert and storm drains near your property.

#### 2024 Tree Trimming

The Village has an established tree maintenance program which consists of the care and improvement of all trees on public property and in the Village right-of-way. The goal is to complete safety pruning for each street tree once every five to seven years.



Tree branches that hang too low can impede sight lines, damage vehicles, injure pedestrians, and impact the health of a tree. The Village will be completing safety pruning on trees, bushes, and other obstructions within the Village right-of-way.

Residents have received a door hanger if there is a tree adjacent to their property that will be trimmed. Tree trimming will begin within the coming weeks, weather dependent.

#### 2024 Pet Licenses

2024 Dog and Cat Licenses are now available. Apply in person at Village Hall or online.

Licenses are required for pets aged five (5) months and older. Proof of current rabies vaccinations with the rabies certificate number and expiration date must be provided to issue the license.

Licenses must be renewed each year. The deadline to apply without an additional fee is March 31.

#### **Protect Your Pipes**

Pipes that have frozen are more likely to leak or burst as temperatures thaw. Avoid leaks by:

- Leaving cabinets open to keep pipes warm.
- Letting indoor faucets drip.
- Keeping outdoor faucets covered.
- Using a hair dryer or heat lamp to safely thaw frozen pipes.

Already had a pipe burst or leak?

- Close your main water shut-off valve.
- Turn off your water heater. Locate the dedicated shut-off valve on the cold water inlet.
- Locate the leak.
- Contact your plumber!
