The Bayside Citizens Academy is a program offered to Bayside residents that aims to provide a closer look at the operations of local government and the jobs of those who work for the Village.

The Academy will be comprised of seven interactive learning sessions led by Village staff who will provide participants with an in-depth look at Village departments and operations including, but not limited to, police, fire and EMS, public works, emergency dispatching, elections, budgeting, property taxes, library, and health. Not only will participants learn about the operation, but also tour the facilities. Yes, that means spend time in jail, listen to 911 calls, sit in the garbage truck, and more.

Participants will navigate the program as a cohort, learning alongside fellow community members. Sessions will be held on specified Wednesday evenings from 6-8pm. The Village will hold a graduation reception at 5:45pm on Thursday, April 18 and a graduation ceremony at 6pm at that

evening's Board of Trustees meeting.

2024 Pet Licenses

Licenses are required for pets aged five (5) months and older. Proof of current rabies vaccinations with the rabies certificate number and expiration date must be provided to issue the license.

Licenses must be renewed each year. The deadline to apply without an additional fee is March 31.

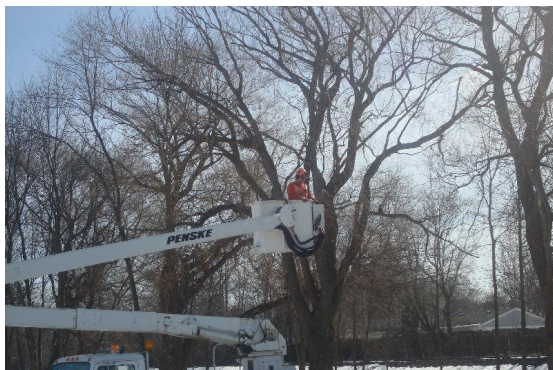
What to Recycle

Keep it simple and only recycle the items listed below:

- Plastic Bottles & Containers
- Food & Beverage Cans
- Paper
- Flattened Cardboard & Paperboard
- Food & Beverage Containers (such as juice cartons)
- Glass Bottles & Containers

These items should not have food or liquids on them. Recyclables should be put loose in the recycling cart or in a paper bag or cardboard box. **NEVER** use plastic bags for recycling. If it's not on the list, it's garbage!

Tree Trimming

The Village of Bayside has an established tree maintenance program which consists of the care and improvement of all trees on public property and in the Village right-of-way. The goal is to complete safety pruning for each street tree once every five to seven years.

Tree branches that hang too low can impede sight lines, damage vehicles, injure pedestrians, and impact the health of a tree. The Village will be completing safety pruning on trees, bushes, and other obstructions within the Village right-of-way.

Prior to safety trimming, residents will be notified with a door hanger at least one week in advance that a tree adjacent to their property will be trimmed.
