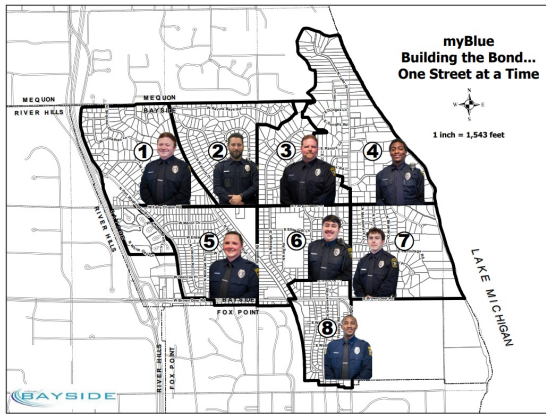


## Don't Forget Your Permit!

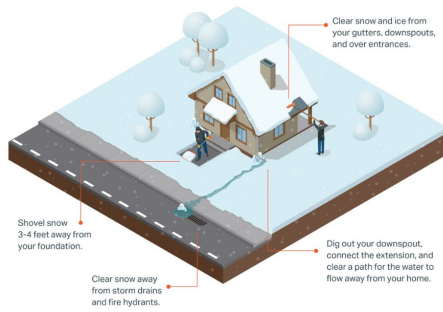

1. Remove snow from your roof.
2. Remove snow 3-5 feet away from

Did you know, Bayside has been a Bird City since 2010?

You can do your part by mitigating for bird collisions in your home and places of business. There are four ways you can keep birds from striking windows:

1. Installing barriers between birds and the window exterior
2. Breaking up reflections that birds see in windows
3. Removing the illusion of a clear passageway
4. Turning off or down-shielding outdoor lighting
