Did you know that garbage, recycling, and yard waste carts are available for rent and purchase?

Garbage:

 Rent a garbage cart (\$40) and have it picked up on your next scheduled



- garbage pick up day.
- Each additional rented cart after the first is \$25.
- Purchase a new garbage cart (\$80) or used cart (\$40) for regular weekly garbage collection. The annual collection fee for a garbage cart is \$103.50.


Recycling:

- Rent a recycling cart (\$40) and have it picked up on your next scheduled recycling pick up day.
- Each additional rented cart after the first is \$25.
- Purchase a recycling cart (\$80) or used cart (\$40) for regular bi-weekly recycling collection.
- Purchase a used cart for \$40.

Yard Waste:

- Purchase a yard waste cart (\$80) for pick up during regular and bagged collections.
- Rent a yard waste cart (\$40) and have it picked up on your next scheduled yard waste pick up week.
- Each additional rented cart after the first is \$25.

Temporary Lane Closure Ahead

We Energies is installing a new power feed for Bayside Middle School. The power feed will result in trenching along the south side of Brown Deer Road, the west and east sides of Regent Road, and the north side of Ellsworth Lane.

Licenses are required for pets aged five (5) months and older. Proof of current rabies vaccinations with the rabies certificate number and expiration date must be provided to issue the license.

Licenses must be renewed each year. The deadline to apply without an additional fee is March 31.
