The Adopt-A-Tree Program is back again this year offering three tree options as we continue our efforts to maintain a 5% species threshold and to diversify the Village's tree population!

#### 2024 Tree Options:

- Autumn Gold Gingko
- Green Gable Black Gum
- Snowdance Tree Lilac

#### Location Options:

- Public Right-of-Way Trees: Cost per tree is \$250 and includes 1 tree, planting in the public right-of-way, mulching and initial watering.
- Private Property Trees: Cost per tree is \$300 and only includes the tree. Trees can be planted on private property.


### I-43 Southbound Ramps @ Brown Deer Road to Close

Beginning Tuesday, March 5 by 8:00pm, the I-43 southbound ramps at Brown Deer Road are scheduled to close long-term for approximately three (3) months while crews continue to construct the new diverging diamond interchange.

#### *Exit Ramp Alternate Route:*

Motorists are encourage to use the I-43 southbound exit ramp to Port Washington Road.

#### *Entrance Ramp Alternate Route:*



Motorists are encouraged to use Brown Deer Road, Green Bay Avenue, and the I-43 southbound entrance ramp at Good Hope Road.

## MAINTENANCE 101:

VILLAGE CODE SEC. 32-55

STORAGE OF ITEMS MUST NOT BE UNSIGHTLY TO THE SURROUNDING VIEW AS TO HAVE AN ADVERSE EFFECT ON ADJOINING OR NEIGHBORING PROPERTIES.



As we move closer to spring, property maintenance becomes a focus of residents and Village Departments alike. We would like to remind everyone of Section 32-55 of the Bayside Municipal Code as it relates to outdoor storage. Storage of items must not be unsightly to the surrounding view as to have an adverse effect on adjoining or neighboring properties

Please help keep Bayside looking beautiful by properly storing items on your property in accordance with the Bayside Municipal Code.
