south end of the existing structure at the center of the south side of the building. He said that currently, it is a load dock area, and they will enclose it to create soil stabilization. He said that there are four overhead doors, and the larger dump trucks will pull in and dump the soil into containers, which then the excavator will sit on to mix the soil to stabilize it. He said it will be dumped into another container at the two outside doors, and those will be picked up and taken away. He said that it is stabilizing the metals within the soil. He said that they use lime dust to stabilize the soil. He said that they do have an eve height of 42 feet to get the dump trucks up without hitting the structure. Mr. Powers asked if there will be anything there that is hazardous.

<u>David Delray from SirCom</u> said that the site is permitted for hazardous waste, but we are going to be using it for content that can't go directly into a landfill. He said we bring in the stabilizer to allow the leaking product to dissipate so they can go to a regular dirt landfill.

Mr. Beverly said that this is the preliminary drawings for the Planning Commission, and once they get approval they will then submit the full set of drawings.

Mr. Montello asked about the number of employees, and Mr. Delray said that they are looking to bring on another 75 to 100 employees. He also said that there is a water treatment side that they are currently working on with Mr. Beverly. City Manager Mallis asked how much water they may utilize for the water treatment process, and Mr. Delray said that he doesn't have an estimate on it right now, but that they are just bringing in the water and will have usage on that side of it.

Mrs. Briggs said this will go before Council at the next Council Meeting on Monday, October 3, 2022, at 8:00 P.M. in Council Chambers.
