

Whether the pool is an in-ground or above ground, must still follow the same requirements. And that is, **MOST IMPORTANT**, the "safety" aspect of having a pool. A resident who has a swimming pool **MUST** either have the entire yard fenced in **OR** must have a locking-type cover/ladder to prevent small children from accessing the pool.

Also, one more item that must be considered is the diameter of the pool. Code requires that the pool must be placed  $\frac{1}{2}$  the distance from the property lines, as what the diameter of the pool is.

**EX:** circular pool - If the pool's diameter is 15' across, it **MUST NOT BE LESS** than  $7 \frac{1}{2}$ ' from the property line. You would figure this same method for rectangular pools.
