Bedford Fire Department

When snow accumulations exceed two inches, a parking ban is put into effect. No parking on any city streets.

The Summer Day Camp is a fun-filled, action packed summer of adventure and new experiences for children ages 5-12 (must be minimum 5 years old on first day of camp and maximum 12 years old on first day of camp). Held at Ellenwood Center, this 8 week camp runs Monday through Friday from 9:00 a.m. to 4:00 p.m., June 10 through August 2. Bedford residents save on Early Bird through February 28.
