Friendly Reminder

Garbage can be placed out the evening prior to pickup after 6:00 p.m., or the morning of pickup before 7:00 a.m. All cans must be removed within 12 hours after pickup.

Open Burning

The Bedford Fire Department would like to remind residents of the open burning policy in the City of Bedford. Please don’t hesitate to call us if you see illegal burning, but remember residents are allowed to have bonfires if they are following the laws.

- The location of any recreational fire shall not be less than 50 feet from a structure, including houses, garages, sheds, etc.
- The material used for burning shall be considered a “clean fuel”, such as seasoned dry firewood, that minimizes the generation and emission of air contaminants.
- Fires that are offensive or objectionable to residents or neighbors due to smoke or odor emissions must be extinguished immediately.

Hydrant Flushing

Hydrant flushing begins June 3, 2019.

Customer tips

- Avoid using the washing machine during times of hydrant flushing.
- If discolored water occurs, simply run the cold water for a few minutes until it clears. This will allow the sediment to work through your pipes.
- In some cases, the discoloration may linger for a few hours. This discoloration of the water only affects the appearance and does not affect the water quality. No health hazards are associated with discolored water from hydrant flushing.
- If water pressure remains low after the flushing has been completed, check your faucet screens or any water filters for trapped particles.

Benefits of hydrant flushing

- Flushes sediments from the water lines and improves water quality.
- Verifies proper operation of fire hydrants and valves.
- Verifies ample water flow for fire fighting.
