- All vehicles or recreational equipment stored on the property must be currently StoryWalk licensed, completely assembled and fully operable. Exception: Inoperable unlicensed vehicles may be stored inside of a garage with the door kept closed.
- Boats and other recreational vehicles may be stored on a paved surface located completely behind a line formed by the front building wall of the dwelling (i.e., beside or behind the house).
