



Ohio is preparing to distribute safe, effective **COVID-19 vaccines** statewide to those who choose to be vaccinated. More information can be found at <u>coronavirus.ohio.gov</u>.

The CDC provided <u>new quarantine guidance</u> for those who have been exposed to COVID-19, but are not showing symptoms.

- 10-day quarantine that does not require testing, provided that there are no symptoms
- 7-day quarantine if test results are negative, provided that there are no symptoms

The **Bar and Restaurant Assistance Fund** is available to assist Ohio's on-premise liquor permit holders impacted by COVID-19. This applies to roughly 30 permit types, including bars, restaurants, breweries, distilleries, wineries, casinos and private clubs. To apply visit: BusinessHelp.Ohio.gov

If an employee is diagnosed with COVID-19:

- Immediately report employee or customer infections to the local health district and identify potentially exposed individuals to help facilitate appropriate contact tracing.
- Professionally clean and sanitize site/location.
- Reopen in consultation with the local health department.

WAYS COMMUNITY LEADERS CAN HELP
