The City of Bedford continues to make adjustments as it pertains to upcoming programming, events, meetings and services. As of November 18th, 2020, Cuyahoga County is designated as Red Alert Level 3 in Ohio's Public Health Advisory System. The Advisory System consists of four alert levels that provide Ohioans with guidance as to the severity of COVID-19 spread in the counties in which they live. Each level is calculated based on seven data-driven health indicators. The Ohio Department of Health will continue to update county rankings every Thursday. Although some of these decisions and guidelines are difficult, ensuring the health and safety of our community is our top priority. The actions of all of us can help schools reopen and keep our businesses open.
