JOB TITLE: Seasonal Labor

REPORTS TO: Parks and Recreation Foreman

NATURE OF WORK

The seasonal grounds maintenance position works mainly outdoors in a team environment, under the direction of the parks and recreation foremen, to maintain outdoor spaces and prepare athletic fields for play. This position is seasonal and may run from April 1- August 30, as needed or assigned. At times the position involves assisting with other programming i.e. setup of indoor spaces at Ellenwood Center.

GENERAL RESPONSIBILITIES

- Maintain a safe work environment
- Follow all equipment safety protocols
- Know and implement emergency procedures when necessary
- Mow, trim, edge greenspaces as directed
- Field preparation including repairing, dragging, lining, applying drying agent, etc. as directed
- Cleanup litter and empty trash
- Maintain playground apparatuses to ensure proper working order
- Maintain proper/safe levels of mulch in playground areas
- Assist with setup, takedown of special events
- · Assist other city departments as assigned
- Perform cleaning duties as assigned/needed
- Maintain a positive image of oneself, the department and City of Bedford at all times
- Report to the foreman or parks and recreation department administration any inquiries or concerns brought by members of the public
- Develop a positive working relationship with department and City staff, participants/user groups and community members
- Report to the foreman or parks and recreation department administration any unsafe conditions or problems with facilities, programs, participants, coaches, instructors, etc.
- Must be dependable and maintain a good work record as to punctuality and daily attendance
- Maintain a clean and neat appearance
- Perform all other duties as assigned

QUALIFICATIONS REQUIRED

- Be able to perform all General Responsibilities satisfactorily
- Ability to remain alert at all times
- Ability to work with minimal supervision

PHYSICAL REQUIREMENTS
