

INVITATION FOR BIDS

Sealed bids will be received by the City Manager of Bedford, and the Mayors of Bedford Heights, Walton Hills, and Orange Village, at Bedford City Hall, 165 Center Road, Bedford, Ohio, until 12:00 o'clock Noon, E.S.T. on the 27th day of April, 2022, for the furnishing of

SOLID WASTE COLLECTION AND RECYCLING PROGRAM

Each bid must contain the full name and address of every person or company interested in said proposal and be accompanied by a 100% bid bond or 5% certified check as a guarantee that if the bid is accepted a contract will be entered into and its performance properly secured. A properly executed Non-Collusion Affidavit and the Delinquent Personal Property Statement are required with each bid.

Should any bid be rejected such check will be forthwith returned to the bidder and should any bid be accepted such check will be returned to the bidder upon proper execution of the contract.

Bids are to be submitted on the Bid Form provided in the bidding documents and shall be enclosed in an opaque sealed envelope plainly marked "REFUSE COLLECTION/DISPOSAL AND RECYCLING PROPOSAL" and shall bear the name of the bidder.

Copies of the bidding documents will be on file for inspection and may be obtained at the Bedford City Hall, 165 Center Road; Bedford Heights City Hall, 5661 Perkins Road; Walton Hills Village Hall, 7595 Walton Road; and Orange Village Hall, 4600 Lander Road.

The right is reserved to reject any and all bids, to waive informalities or irregularities in the bidding process and to enter into a contract with the bidder whom, in the opinion of the Solid Waste Consortium, offers the lowest responsive and responsible bid.
