CHECK YOUR WATER SERVICE LINE FOR LEAD

Water mains are not made of lead; however, the water service line that carries the water from the main in the street to you home could be. Homeowners' service lines may be made of lead, copper, galvanized steel, or plastic. Please assess your WATER service line where it enters tour home, typically in the basement, near your water meter.

ACTION REQUIRED:

DETERMINE YOUR SERVICE LINE MATERIAL

YOU WILL NEED:

- Key or Coin
- Magnet

WHAT TO DO





A magnet will <u>not</u> stick to lead pipe. If the scratched area is a shiny silver and flakes off, the service line is lead.

COPPER PIPE:

A magnet will <u>not</u> stick to copper pipe. If the scratched area is a copper color, like a penny, the service line is copper.

GALVANIZED PIPE:

A magnet <u>will</u> stick to galvanized pipe. A scratch test is not needed. If you do scratch the pipe, it will remail a dull gray.
