BOYS AND GIRLS AGES 5-12

Weeknights beginning in June; weather permitting. Volunteers are needed to help coordinate each team. Practice may begin in late May or June and will be scheduled based on coaches availability. Participants receive a game shirt and hat. Every player should have a pair of white baseball pants and a mitt.

The number of registered participants at any age group will determine the program format. Games in some divisions may be played against teams in the Maple Heights Boys League in both City of Bedford parks and Stafford Park in Maple Heights. T-ball will likely be played fully in Bedford. In the event that participation numbers do not allow for multiple teams in each age group, the Parks & Recreation Department may run the program in a camp/clinic format with instruction from Rookie Sports Club, LLC.

A player may not turn the next age prior to May 1.

Divisions may vary based on registration. Days of the week may change at any time.
